CV: Hermann Schlimme studied Architecture at the Technische Universität Braunschweig and at the Universities of Edmonton and Florence. 1998 PhD in History of Architecture, Braunschweig, with a thesis on early modern church facades in Rome. Scientific Collaborator at the Bibliotheca Hertziana, Max Planck Institute for Art History, Rome, especially scientific direction of the research program "Epistemic History of Architecture" (cooperation with the Max Planck Institute for the History of Science, Berlin). Co-editor of "Construction History. International Journal of the Construction History Society" (peer-reviewed) and member of the management





committee of the society (since 2013). Research project on the Western Buildings in the Old Summer Palace Yuanmingyuan in Beijing, cooperation with Beijing Tsinghua Institute for Digitization (THID, Tsinghua University, Beijing). 2014-2016 Guest Professor at the Technische Universität Wien (Vienna). Since 2017 Professor for History of Architecture and Urbanism at the Technische Universität Berlin. Schlimme's research focuses on the history of architecture in Early Modern Italy and its impact outside Italy, Epistemic History of Architecture, Construction History and History of 20th and 21st Century Architecture.
