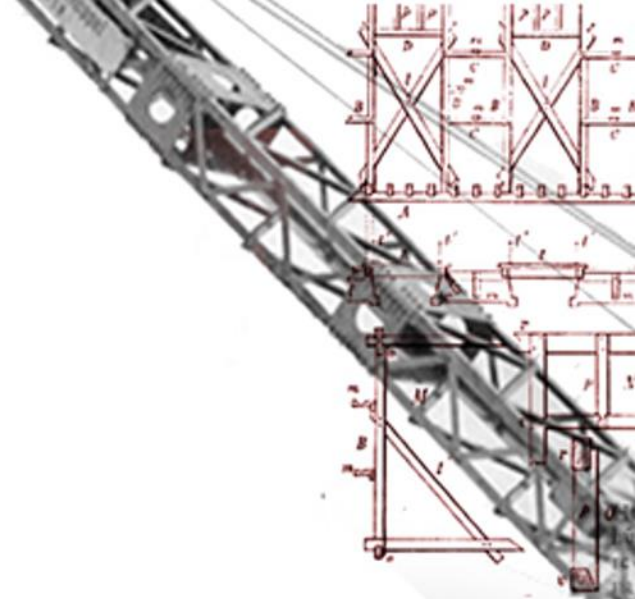

He is a research assistant at CHAM - Centre for the Humanities (CHAM) of the Universidade NOVA de Lisboa and Universidade dos Açores and at the Camões Interdisciplinary Studies Centre (CIEC) of the Universidade de Coimbra. During his academic studies, mainly dedicated to palatial architectural culture - royal, episcopal and inquisitorial - he presented several communications, lectures and conferences, published in articles and book chapters, in Portugal, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, France, Germany, Greece, Spain and the United Kingdom.
