Villette from 2003 to 2015. He is associated researcher at MAP-MAACC UMR 3495 CNRS/MCC and editor of the «Architecture and computer science» ISTE series. He is member of the French-speaking association of Construction History. His research on construction history focuses on the study of stability of historic masonry and on the study of historic methods historical methods of structural design, particularly those using graphic statics.
