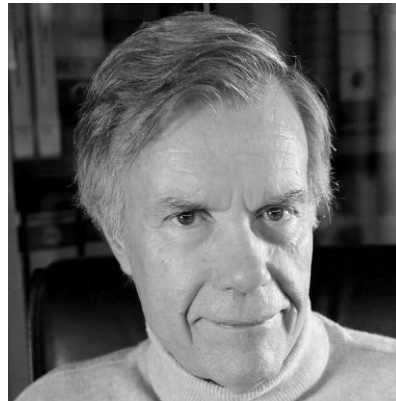


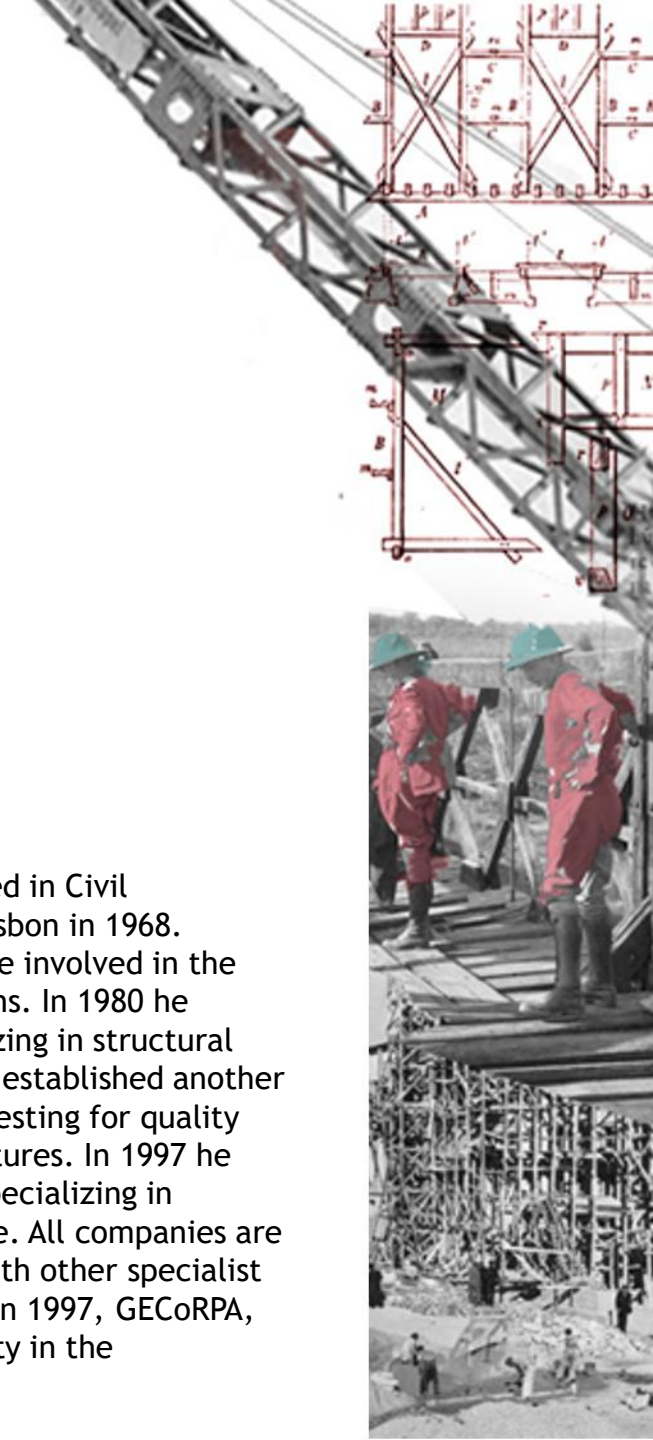

CV: Vítor Córias, retired since 2016, graduated in Civil Engineering at the Technical University of Lisbon in 1968. Worked at the L.N.E.C., Lisbon, then became involved in the design of concrete structures and foundations. In 1980 he established Stap, a contracting SME specializing in structural rehabilitation and strengthening. In 1985 he established another company, Oz, dealing with survey and NDT testing for quality control, diagnostics and monitoring of structures. In 1997 he established a third company, Monumenta, specializing in ancient structures and architectural heritage. All companies are operating, hiring around 90 people. Along with other specialist SMEs, these three companies founded, also in 1997, GECORPA, an association dedicated to promoting quality in the

conservation of the built Heritage and in the structural rehabilitation of existing buildings at large. Vítor Cóias is a specialist in structures with the Portuguese Order of Engineers and a former member of its Assembly of Representatives, member of the Consulting Board of ICOMOS Portugal and expert member of ISCARSAH (ICOMOS committee on heritage structures). He is also member of the Portuguese Construction History Society and several local and international environmental and human rights NGO. His specialties include structural assessment, inspection and testing of ancient buildings regarding evaluation and diagnosis (author of a book on this subject) and design of constructive and structural interventions in architectural heritage with emphasis on seismic behavior (author of a book on this subject).
